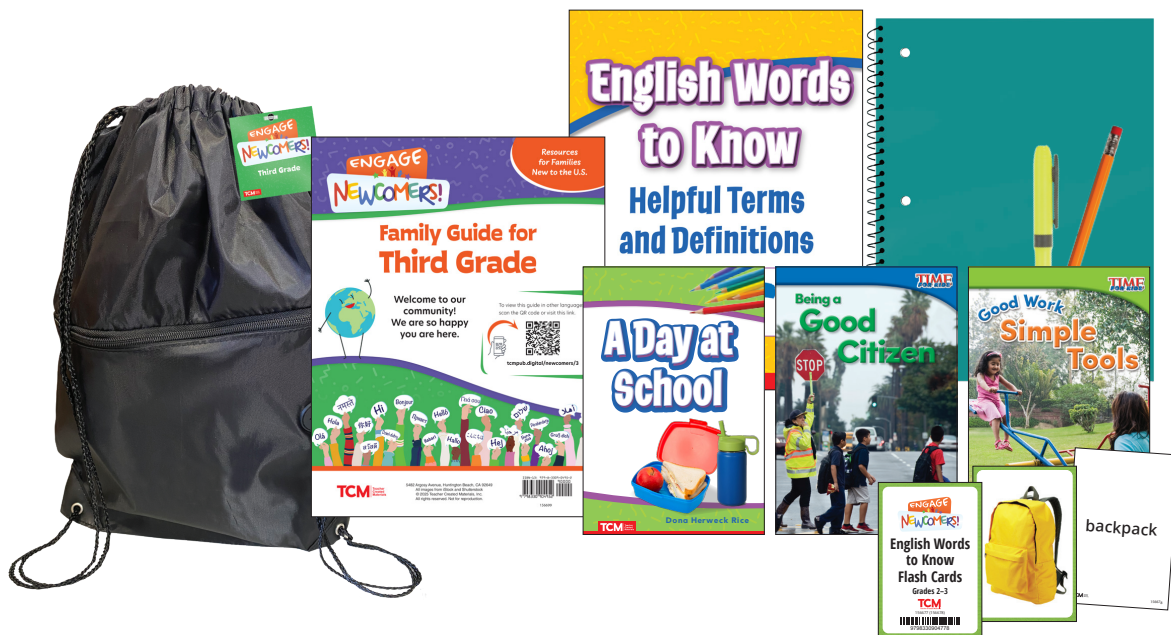

# Included in Your Backpack

## English Words to Know Flash Cards

These flash cards will help your child learn English words. You may choose to use a translation app to hear how each word is pronounced.



## Learn with a Game!

- **Four in a Row:** Arrange 16 cards in 4 rows of 4 cards with the pictures showing. Have one player choose a card and say the English word. Turn it over to see if they are correct. Place a sticky note on the card. Write the player's name on the sticky note to show who said the right word. Play until a player gets 4 in a row.
- **Spell It:** Hold up a card so your child can see the picture. Have your child say the English word. Then, have your child write the word on a piece of paper. Turn the card around to see if your child spelled it correctly.
- **What Is Missing?:** Place 10 to 20 cards in rows with the pictures showing. Have your child point to each card and say the English word. Then, have your child close their eyes. Remove one of the cards. Ask your child if they can identify the card that is missing.








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## Words to Know
